

#### **NYUNGAR TOURS**

#### **South Perth Walk**

O South Perth

(L) 45 minutes (L) 30 people



Explore the tranquil oasis of South Perth's Scented Gardens. Here, you'll learn about plants used for bush foods and medicinal purposes, and get the opportunity to touch and feel Aboriginal artefacts.

#### **Kings Park Cultural Tours**

Visit Pioneer Women's Memorial place and learn about the significance of Yorgas (women), while taking in the magnificent gardens of Kings Park and outlook of Perth city and the Swan River. Here, you can walk among the treetops and enjoy the spectacular views over a glass arched bridge suspended among a canopy of tall eucalypts.

#### **Goologoolup Tours** (Yagan Square)

Dedicated to the Noongar Greats of Perth, this short powerful talk is the perfect length for a limited (e.g. lunchtime) timeframe. Hear about Yagan, son of Midgegeroo, who was just one of the many tribal leaders to fight for his People and their Lands in the earliest days of the Swan River Colony in the locale now known as Perth. Hear their stories of heroic resistance.

#### **Goomup Tour (Elizabeth Quay)** & Karrgatup Tour (Kings Park)

In this walking tour at 'Karrgatup' (Kings Park) Perth or 'Goomup' (Elizabeth Quay) in Perth's CBD, you'll learn of the city's first Aboriginal story and spiritual significance to Noongar People - beginning with a Noongar Welcome to Country and including Dreamtime stories, traditional song, tools and language.

#### Djoogan Keeninyirra

Experience dance and song, an important part of Noongar storytelling, through the Djoogan Keeninyirra dancers. In visually striking ceremonial costumes, these dancers bring ancient cultural stories to life in spectacular fashion through song, dance and ceremonial ochre body paint.

#### **Welcome to Country**

A Welcome to Country is an Aboriginal greeting performed by a Traditional Owner of those Lands. Performing this will be Walter McGuire, a descendant from several Noongar language groups of the South West including the Wadjuk lands of Perth and its outer suburbs..

Feel cleansed as you pass through the smoke infused with the aromas of the Australian bush. This ancient ritual is accompanied by traditional songs and their interpretations, sung in the Noongar Whadjuk dialect.
