

 StudyPerth will offer confidential counselling as delivered by Multicultural Services Centre of WA.


- Our goal is to provide a safe environment with our qualified wellbeing professionals in our Student Hub – connecting international students with information, referral and practical support.
- We can assist with situations related to:
 - Anxiety or depression
 - Traumatic events (recent or those in the past)
 - Problematic use of alcohol and/or other drugs
 - Sexuality
 - Pre-existing mental health concerns
 - Other distressing circumstances

The Wellbeing Support Program is being delivered in partnership with the WA Government, StudyPerth and the broader international education sector, and is supported by Lotterywest.



Legal Support – My Legal Mate

- Free multilingual and confidential legal advice via My Legal Mate
- Students can easily access confidential and free legal information, as well as answers to commonly asked questions about laws in Australia.
- For any legal matter related to:
 - Private disputes and sexual assault
 - Employment and workplace rights
 - Housing/tenancy issues
 - Motor vehicle insurance and purchase
- StudyPerth will also offer free in-person legal advice, as delivered by Northern Suburbs Community Legal Centre, at our centrally located Student Hub. Our in-person lawyer will be able to discuss students' options and the next steps to take.
